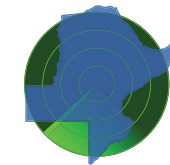

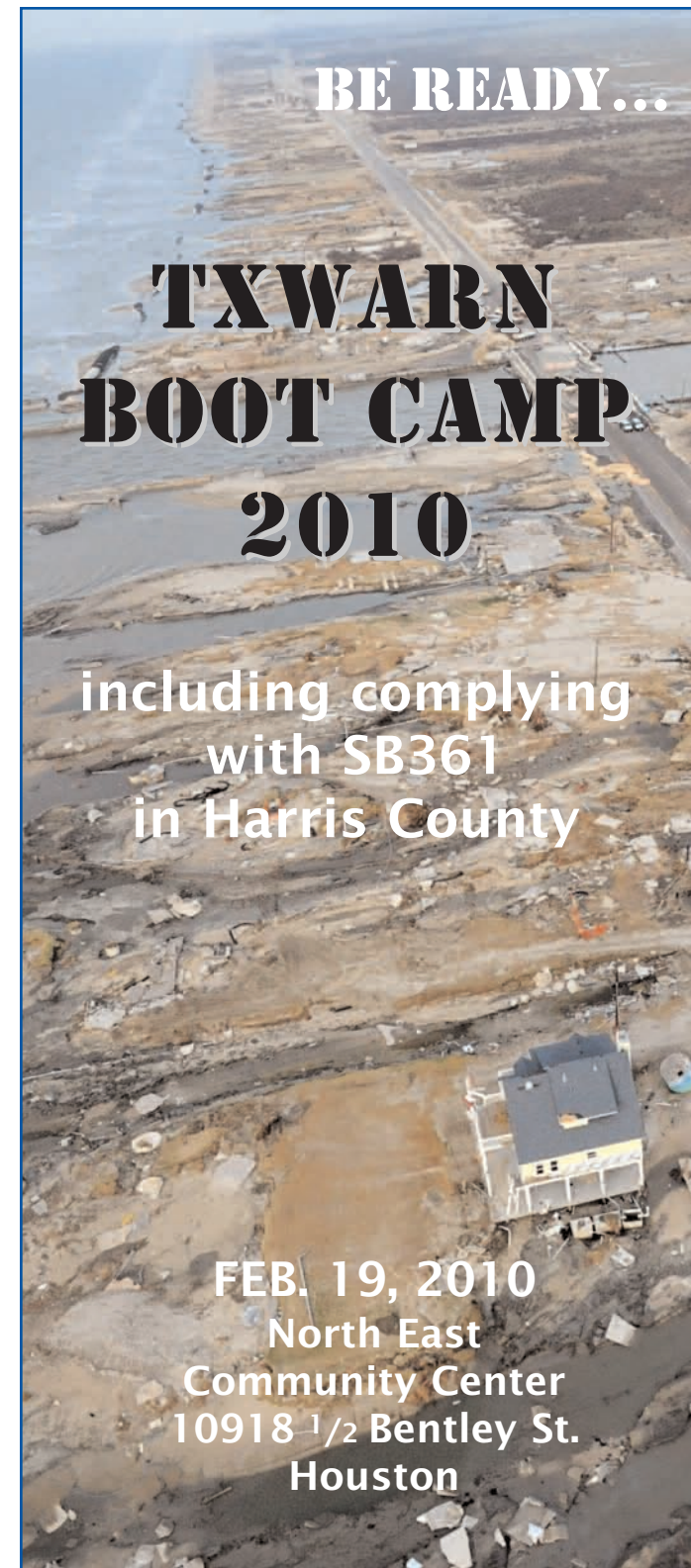

After Hurricane Ike, the Texas Legislature weighed in with SB361, which requires Harris County drinking water providers to prepare an Emergency Preparedness Plan and file it with TCEQ by March 1.

Some utilities may be able to meet SB361 requirements by being a TXWARN member.
