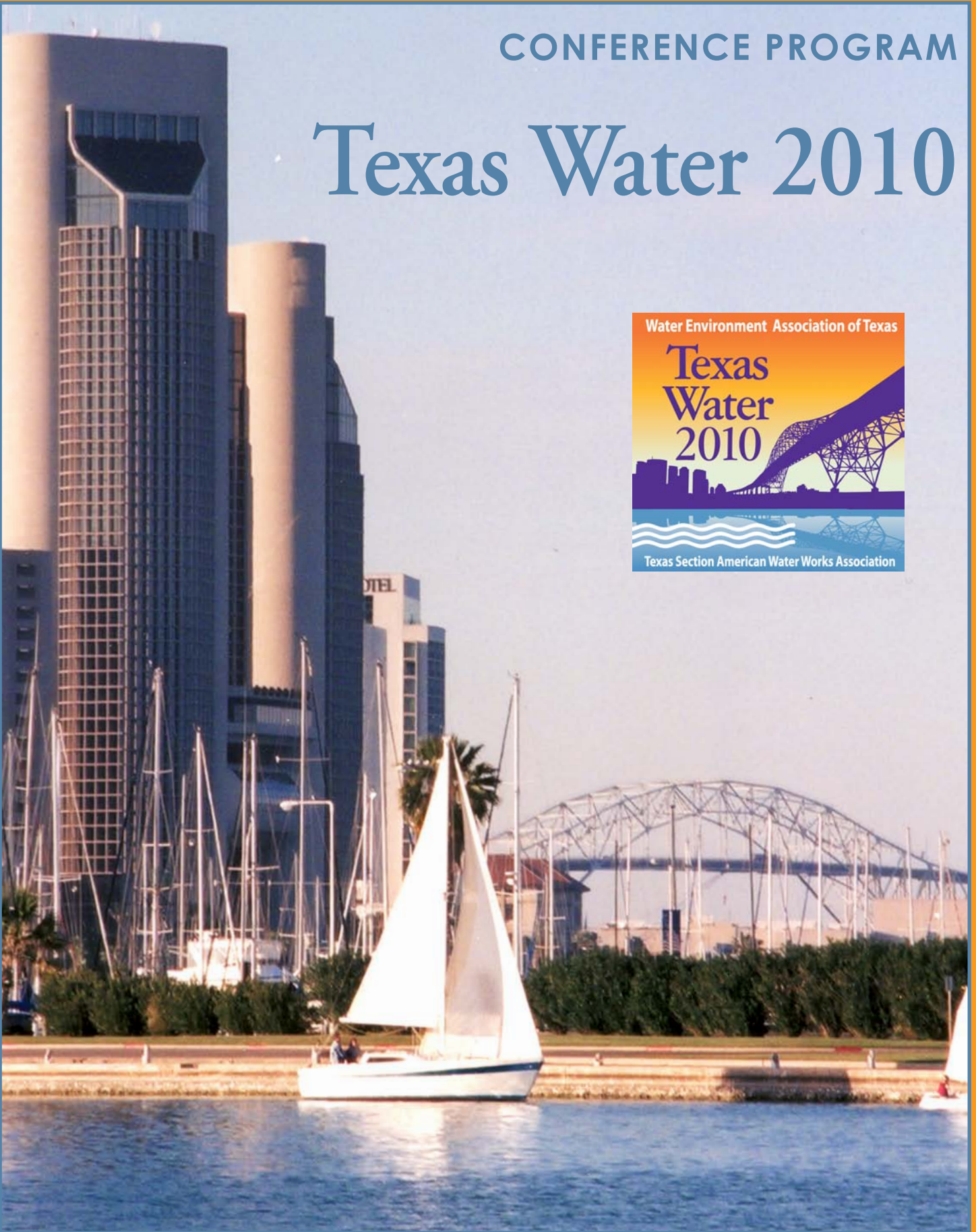
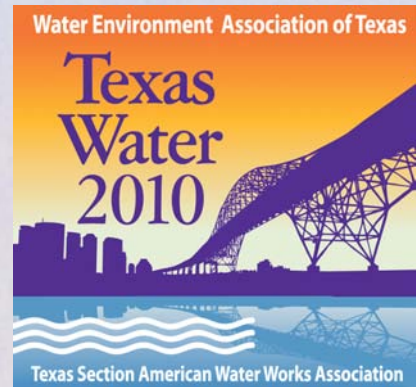

Brooks opens TW10

Dr. Bryan Brooks, associate professor of environmental science at Baylor University, keynotes the Opening Session at Texas Water 2010.



His research currently focuses on water quality dynamics of rapidly urbanizing regions, developing approaches to define contaminants of emerging concern (e.g., pharmaceuticals, personal care products, endocrine active substances), water reuse, and the ecology and environmental toxicology of harmful algae blooms.

Brooks has served as the past president of South Central SETAC, the Gulf Coast Society of Toxicology and the Texas River and Reservoir Management Society.

WEF leader visits

WEF President-Elect Jeanette Brown will head to Corpus Christi for Texas Water 2010.



Currently the Executive Director of the Stamford Water Pollution Control Authority, she is also an adjunct professor of environmental engineering at Manhattan College in Riverdale, N.Y.

She has been a WEF member since 1976, has served on its House of Delegates since 2004 and has been involved with several WEF committees.

She has also co-chaired and authored many of WEF's publications, published numerous papers, and is on the editorial board of the *Journal of the U.S. SJWP*.

He is the Water Quality Coordinator for the Tualatin Valley Water District in Beaverton, Oregon.

TCEQ has approved Texas Water 2010 for a maximum of 11 hours of Operator Training Certification credit for water personnel and 10.5 hours for wastewater personnel. Credit hours will be available for attending some technical sessions. Competitors in WEAT's Operator Competition and in TAWWA's Top Ops contest may also receive ten hours of credit. Forms are available at the registration counters. Complete the forms indicating the technical sessions you attended.

Forms must be returned to the registration desk before Texas Water 2010 ends. You must have your TCEQ Operator ID# for credit.

Engineers may also receive licensing CE hours for attending on a self-reporting basis. Forms are available at the registration counters.

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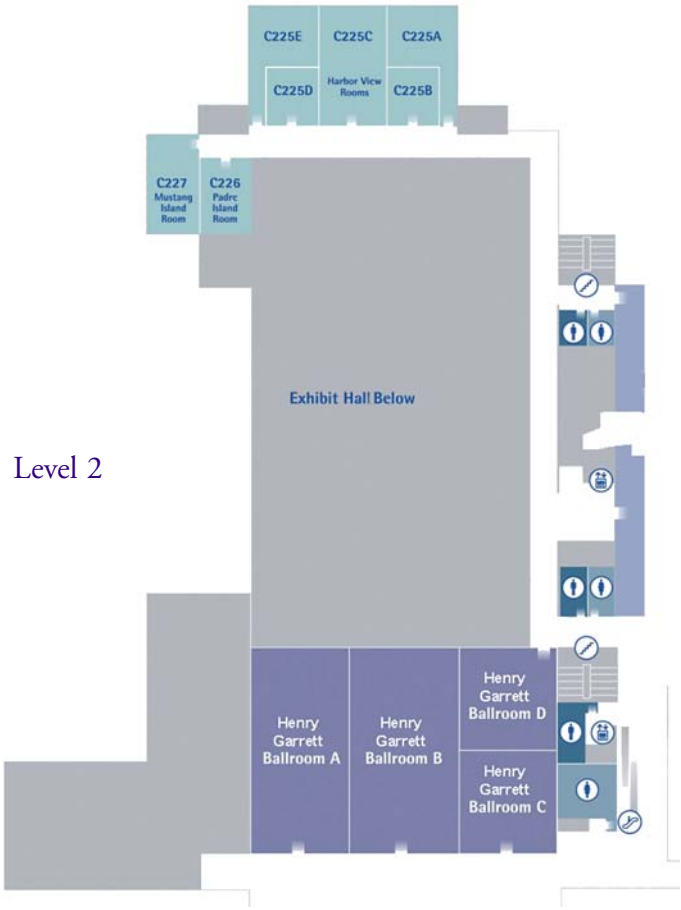
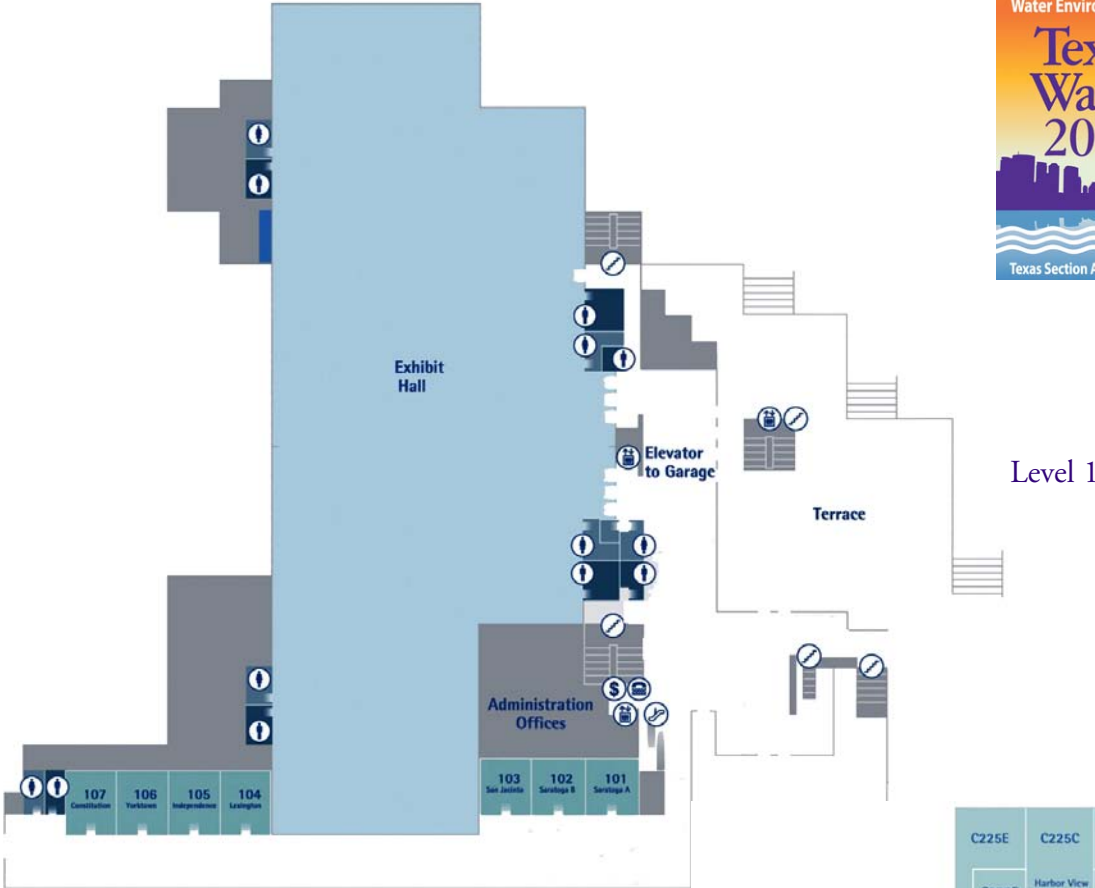
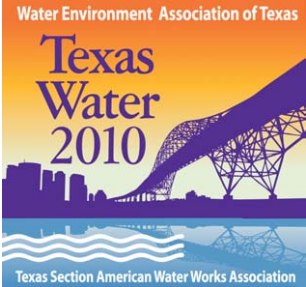
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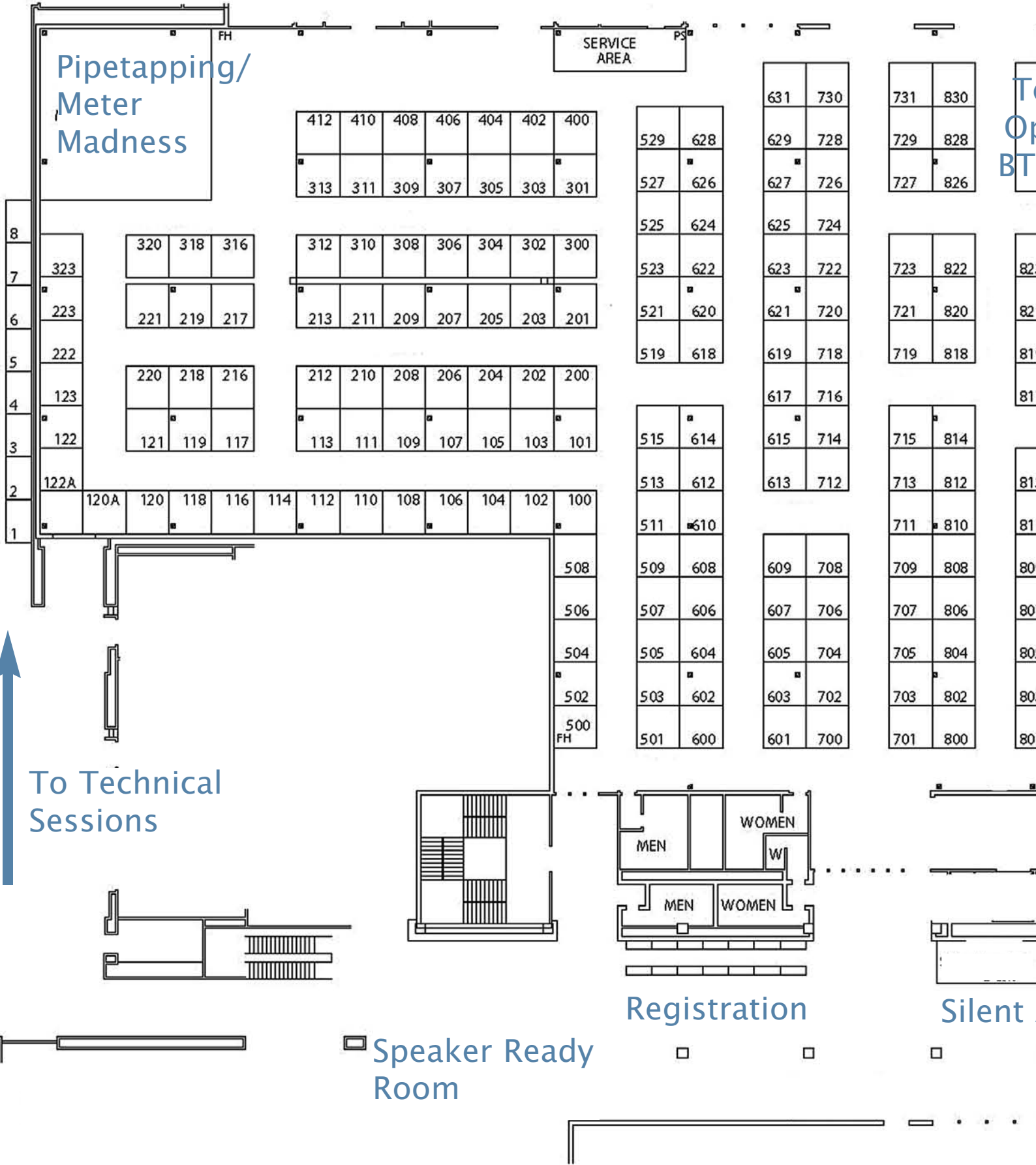
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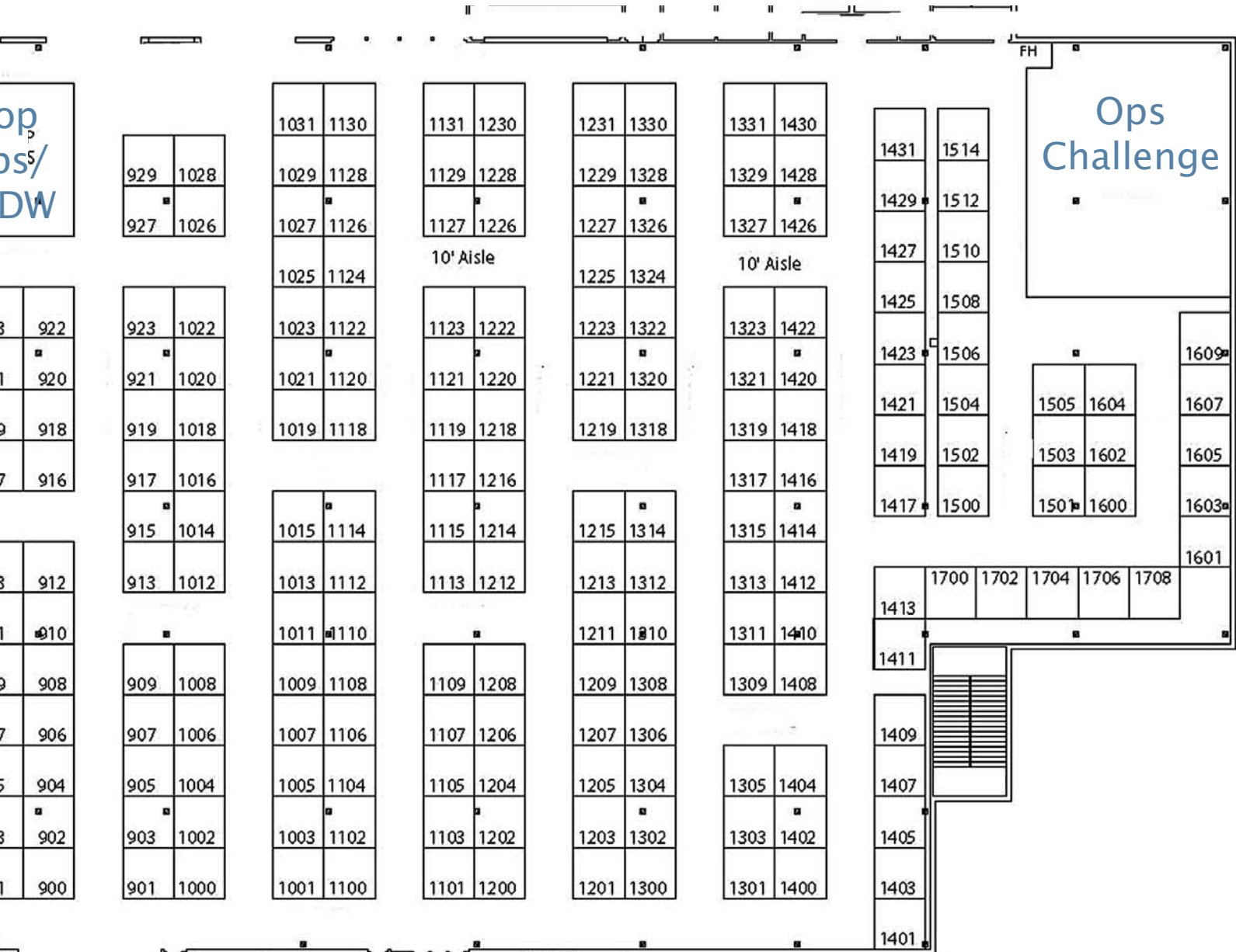
